About the Wine - Kiona's Late Harvest Riesling is crafted from select vineyards that emphasize great ripening potential and concentrated flavor development from the Columbia Valley and surrounding areas. Picked in late October, the Riesling grapes in this wine were nearly 27% sugar and exhibited signs of raisining, a desirable trait that contributes greatly to the finish of this wine.

Tasting Notes - Honeysuckle and floral notes mesh well with well-balanced honey and apricot flavors that linger on the palate. Avoids the cloying nature of many late harvest wines with a nice mouth-watering acidity that helps to balance the sugar.
